### Program Format

The Leadership Program begins with a mandatory full-day orientation session, followed by fourteen 2.5 - 3 hour sessions, one additional full-day session and an evening commencement ceremony.

### Program Requirements

In addition to the full-day orientation participants must attend at least thirteen sessions in order to graduate from the program.
